### **QUICK REFERENCE SHEET:**

#### **MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM HNI CERTIFICATION PROGRAM**

#### **What will be offered:**

- **Master of Christian Ministry degree (MCM) and HarvestNet Ministry Certification (HMC)**  
Students will choose a concentration with a particular ministry focus to satisfy their core elective requirements such as:  
    >> Concentration in church planting skills   >> Concentration in missions ministry skills  
    >> Concentration in pastoral ministry skills   >> Concentration in youth ministry skills
- **ALSO - Special Certificates are available in: (1) Anglican Studies; (2) Marketplace Ministry**  
These are stand alone certificates of 3 courses each, or substitute for the core elective requirements in either the MCM or the HMC programs.

#### **Points of interest – Particulars involved with the Programs:**

- The MCM and HCM programs can be completed in two to four (2-4) years.
- The Program is divided into 60% classroom training and 40% hands-on mentoring
- General Academic calendar:
  - 13 week semesters in Fall and Spring + occasional summer classes offered.
  - Seminar classes generally offered in December, January and in May.
- The main required courses are offered as Tuesday evening classes plus a mentoring session:
  - 1 night / week – 7:00 to 10:15 pm of classroom instruction, 2 courses / night can be taken.
  - 1 time / week meeting with Mentor for about 2-3 hours at a time mutually agreed upon.
- The Masters and Certification curriculum involves a total of 51 credit hours
- Course structures include: 8 semester length courses of 13 weeks; a December Freedom Weekend Seminar; a Short Term Mission Trip; and 5 intensive seminars during January, May & July Terms. The 3 courses for the Anglican Studies, or the Marketplace Ministries Studies or the Core Electives in the student's area of focus and interest may be offered as intermittent classes, seminars or independent study work.
- All of the courses are 3 credit hour classes except for the Freedom Weekend Seminar (1 cr.), the 7 Life Languages Seminar (1 cr.) and the Short Term Mission Trip (2 or 3 cr.).
- The short term mission (STM) field ministry experience is to provide cross-cultural experience. This is required to graduate unless a special exemption is given. This STM trip of 1-2 weeks in duration is ideally to be scheduled at the beginning of the student's first fall semester for the following summer. Trips to several international destinations are available.
- A comprehensive exam is administered at the conclusion of studies (or Thesis option for Certificate Students).

#### **Costs:**

- Fees: \$50 = Application Fee; \$45 = Seven Life Languages Fee (paid online); \$150 = Graduation Fee.
- Graduate tuition costs: \$200 / credit hour. Total Credit Hours: 51. Current TOTAL tuition cost: \$10,200.00.
- Certificate tuition costs: \$125 / credit hour. Total Credit Hours: 51. Current TOTAL tuition cost: \$6375.00.

- The student is also responsible for additional costs for books, Life Languages on-line diagnostic and supplies.
- Actual trip cost of short term mission trip (varies with the trip).

**NOTE: You must have a BA / BS in any field (provisional acceptance if G.P.A. is lower than 3.0) for the Masters Degree Program. You must have a high school diploma for the Certification Program.**

- Have your local pastor complete a *Pastor's Reference Form* (available online, or via mail). Your pastor should send the recommendation directly to HarvestNet Institute.
- Have two (2) Letters of Personal Reference sent directly to the Registrar at HarvestNet Institute. These letters should address your character, ministry gifts and calling observations.
- Arrange to schedule an interview date.
- Regular Fall Enrollment DEADLINE is July 31<sup>st</sup>.**
