QUICK REFERENCE SHEET:

MASTERS DEGREE PROGRAM **HNI CERTIFICATION PROGRAM**

What will be offered:

- **Master of Christian Ministry degree (MCM) and HarvestNet Ministry Certification (HMC)**
Students choose a concentration in a specific ministry focus to satisfy their core elective requirements such as:
>> Concentration in church planting skills. >> Concentration in marketplace ministry skills
>> Concentration in Anglican Studies >> Concentration in missions ministry skills.
- **Special Certificates are offered in (1) Church Planting; (2) Marketplace Ministry; (3) Anglican Studies.** These are stand alone certificates of 3 courses of 3 credits each.

Particulars involved with the Programs:

- The MCM and HCM programs can be completed normally in two to four (2-4) years.
- Program is divided into 60% classroom training and 40% hands-on ministry and mentoring
- **General Academic calendar:**
 - 13 week semesters in Fall and Spring, plus one or two summer seminar classes.
 - Seminars classes generally offered in December, January, May and July.
- Evening classes – generally:
 - 1 night / week – 7:00 to 10:15 pm of classroom instruction, 2 courses/night. (*Currently Tuesday evenings*)
 - 1 time / week meeting with Mentor for about 3-4 hours at a time mutually agreed upon.
- The study programs normally involve 8 semester courses of 13 weeks, a Freedom Weekend Seminar, a Short Term Mission Trip and 8 intensive seminars during December, January, May and Summer Terms. [NOTE: Three of these seminars are core electives in the student's area of focus and interest. One of these seminars (Pneumatology) is a required core elective.]
- All of the courses are 3 credit hour classes except for the Freedom Weekend Seminar and 7 Life Languages Seminar (1 cr. Each), and the Short Term Mission course (2-3 credits).
- A comprehensive exam is administered at the conclusion of studies (or Thesis option for Certificate Students).

Costs:

- Fees: \$50 Application Fee; \$150 Graduation Fee; \$45 Life Languages Assessment Fee (paid online).
- Graduate tuition costs: \$200 / credit hour. Total Credit Hours: 51-52. Current tuition: \$10,200-\$10,400.
- Certificate tuition costs: \$125 / credit hour. Total Credit Hours: 51-52. Current tuition: \$6,375 - \$6,500

- The student is also responsible for additional costs for books, Life Languages on-line diagnostic and supplies.
- Actual trip cost of short term mission trip (varies with the trip).

Beginning Your Application Process:

NOTE: You must have a BA / BS in any field (provisional acceptance if G.P.A. is lower than 3.0) for the Masters Degree Program. You must have a high school diploma for the Certification Program.

- Call the office to discuss questions, schedule an information meeting, and/or receive enrollment information. (216.335.9355)
- Fill out and mail in your Application Form and non-refundable \$50 application fee. You can request an Application Form by sending an email or letter to HarvestNet or downloading from www.harvestnet.net.
- Have transcripts from previous post-high school institutions attended mailed to HarvestNet Registrar.
- Have your local pastor complete the *Pastor's Reference Form*. Your pastor should send the recommendation directly to HarvestNet Institute.
- Have two (2) Letters of Personal Reference sent directly to the Registrar at HarvestNet Institute. These letters should address your character, ministry gifts and calling observations.
- Arrange to schedule an interview date.
