Mentoring Coaching Assignments

Disciple Making DS/200

OUTCOMES TO BE ACHIEVED BY END OF SEMESTER:

- Mentor please attend at least one classroom lecture with student
- Have Student model and teach their disciple(s) to pray.
- Have Student introduce their disciple to the concept of “prayer walking” and do a prayer walk of their neighborhood.
- Have Student teach their disciple the Bible Study Methods scripture study template of Who, What, When, Where, Why & How.
- Have Student present simulation of 4 Laws and/or Your Most Important Relationship booklet to their disciple.
- Have student’s disciple do a presentation of 4 Laws and/or Your Most Important Relationship booklet
- Have Student present simulation of Holy Spirit booklet to their disciple.
- Have Student teach their disciple to do a presentation of Holy Spirit booklet.
- Participate in a kindness/power evangelism project.

SEMESTER (13 week) SEQUENCE DEVELOPMENT

First Meeting:

- You and your student meet together to get acquainted
- Discuss the utilization of the “weekly schedule” (attached)
- Future goal of student having their own discipleship group (This could be new converts or newer believers from student’s home church)
- Review 4 spiritual laws booklet with student
- **Make candidate list of the top 5-10 names of people to disciple**
- Ask student to pray

Second Meeting:

- Discuss sowing & reaping activities & brainstorm about future Outreach possibilities
 - Ask student how they are acclimatizing to class, homework and their readings
 - Assign students to meet with their disciple(s) in place of next mentoring meeting
- And:
- 1) Learn their disciples' spiritual history
 - 2) Conduct a simulation of **4 Spiritual Laws/Most important relationship** w/disciples
- Check on student's progress in follow-ups (5)

Third Meeting: *(Student's to meet with their disciples w/o Mentors)*

- Student's learn their disciple's spiritual history- talk about the discipleship process
- Conduct a simulation of 4 Laws/Most Important Relationship booklets w/disciples
- Pray for each other
- Get verbal report of how meeting with student's disciples went.

Fourth Meeting *(Student's to meet with disciples w/o Mentors)*

- Students & their disciple(s) pray for a fruitful time together
- Students to have **disciples conduct** presentation (ideally, at least 3) of 4 Laws/Most Important Relationship/Holy Spirit booklet(s) {go with disciples if necessary}.
- Students discuss with their disciples & identify a target area to Prayer walk **NEXT WEEK**.
- Pray for each other

Fifth Meeting *(Students meet with their disciples – MENTORS PRESENT TO OBSERVE)*

- **Student & disciple Prayer Walk target area**
- **Assign student** to conduct simulation presentation of the Ministry of the Holy Spirit with their disciples next week.
- **Discuss, Decide & Plan for a kindness/power evangelism or outreach event with the student and their disciples** → *think in terms of doing something to reinforce local church Easter outreach.*
- Check on students progress in follow-ups (5)
- Pray for each other

Sixth Meeting

→ **POSSIBLE GROUP MEETING of ALL Mentors, Students and Disciples to finalize plans for joint kindness evangelism outreach event.**

- Meet and pray to **discuss details for the witnessing /outreach event**
- Student monitors a disciple's **presentation** of the Ministry of the Holy Spirit booklet.
- Students assign disciples to seek to share presentations of 4 Laws and/or Ministry of the Holy Spirit booklets over coming week.
- Pray for each other

Seventh Meeting

- **Go & Do** the witnessing/outreach event (mentor, student & disciples)
Hopefully will not occur LATER THAN THE WEEKEND PRIOR TO RESURRECTION DAY (April 12)
- Share and evaluate the outreach
- Pray over any significant contacts from the event

Eighth Meeting (*Students meet with their disciples w/o Mentors*)

- Students & their disciple(s) discuss "How to study the Bible effectively"; utilize the BSMETHODS approach of "Who, What When, Where, Why How."
- Pray for each other

Ninth Meeting (*Mentors possibly attend lecture*)

- Discuss "Motivating others to Join a Discipleship Group"
- Pray for each other

Tenth Meeting (*Mentors possibly attend lecture*)

- Mentor observe and meet with student and with **student's discipleship** group
- Pray for each other

Eleventh Meeting

- Mentor observe and meet with student and with **student's discipleship** group

Twelfth Meeting

- Discuss a plan for the future development of the student's discipleship group
- Discuss with the student **the book** they chose to read

Thirteenth Meeting

- Meet and pray
- Go over any final areas in the **check-out** that need completed

- Discuss highlights of the Discipleship course and highlights of the field experience
