**Course Description**

This course will survey the following inter-connected areas:

- World View & Anglicanism: past, present & future and the challenge of a post-Christian western society, including current developments vis-à-vis new emerging Anglican alignments worldwide.
- Global Anglicanism: history and development the Anglican Communion churches of the non-Western world, with particular focus on the global south (2/3rds world).
- Anglican Mission: a missional approach to the proclamation of the Gospel message – both domestically via Kingdom-advancing church plants and re-plants, regionally by collaborative efforts with cross-denominational alliances, and internationally via global engagement strategies using holistic missionary methodologies.
- Anglican Structure and polity – with particular focus on developing a “three-fold cord” that weaves the best of evangelical orthodoxy, charismatic empowerment and historic liturgical richness into a dynamic and missional structure.
- Anglican Community in the Local Church – a look at the ground of being of any church movement... the local congregation, and how to nurture a healthy, loving and growing community of faith that ministers wholeness, healing and truth in a transformational environment.
